- 17 Transfer to port city of Piraeus. Board ship for 4-day cruise to Greek Islands and Turkey. 1st port of call is Mykonos. (B,L, D).
- 18 Arrive Kusadasi. Optional tour of Ephesus. Tour island of Patmos and Monastery of the Apocalypse. (B,L,D).
- 19 Arrive city of Rhodes. (B,L,D).
- 20 Optional excursions to Heraklion. Sail to the island of Santorini. (B,L,D).
- 21 Arrive to Piraeus. Transfer to half-day tour of Athens. Afternoon at leisure. (B)
- 22 Athens. Day at leisure. (B)
- 23 Transfer to airport for trans-Atlantic flight to U.S.A. (B)

TCC Scholarships: Study Abroad Scholarships are available for qualified students who are registered for the class(s) associated with this program. Funds are limited, so please apply early. Scholarship application deadline is **February 1, 2010**.

Scholarship Eligibility:

- Be accepted into a TCC faculty-led overseas program.
- Must submit a complete scholarship application that includes 3 letters of recommendation.
- Enroll in the course associated with this program.
- Be enrolled at least half time **and** have completed at least nine curricular (non developmental) credits at TCC at the time of application.
- Have a GPA of at least 2.5 or higher.

Payment Schedule: A deposit of \$700 is required with a completed program application. A payment of \$1040 is due on January 22, 2010; a final payment of \$1040 is due on February 22, 2010. Contact the Office of International Programs for details on cancellation policies. **Payments must be made by check, money order, or credit card to the International Programs office at the Virginia Beach campus.**

- **Late payments may subject you to being dropped from the program and a loss of fees paid to date on your behalf to travel providers.**

Cancellations: Travel provider penalties apply. Travel insurance is strongly recommended.
